THE RIM COUNTRY WORK- This has been another unusual month. The Brian Mullers went on their regular scheduled vacation which left some holes in our attendance. Brother Dan Smyers taught Brian's last class on the book of Revelation instead of starting a series on Mormonism. Then, the Smyers, being exposed to the Covid-19 put themselves in quarantine and missed some studies, I had to do all the work one Sunday. All the prayers, song leading, teaching, the Lord's Supper and the preaching. We had another sister out spending some time with her daughter in Flagstaff who was going to have an operation.

My wife has had a bad case of the shingles on top of her regular pain. She has really been miserable going back and forth from her lift chair to bed and back again in a cycle, trying to find relief from the "waves of pain" as she calls it. This past Sunday she forced herself to go to worship. She has missed several times.

There was a bright side to the month knowing that the Littles couple would become a part of the congregation as they moved from Mesa Az to Payson at the beginning of October. More about them in the next report.

We ended the study on "Peer Pressure" that I was teaching on Sunday morning. We have had no visitors except that Rick Skoglund attends as his health allows him to come. His caretakers are also in bad health. We have missed him the last two Sundays of October. I was in Florida for at my brother's funeral the first Sunday in September, so here are the sermons preached for the rest of September: Important Questions of Life; Fundamental Mistakes of "Women in Ministry" Part 1, then Part 2 the next Sunday.

AFRICA -Mozambique;

Arao Uchaio who has been visiting and preaching at the church at Massegir twice a month has related their need for food. They did not receive rain in that part of the country as other parts did and so they had no crops to harvest. They were helped a few of months ago but now they are out of food. Arao says "*if they can be help for one more time as we are approaching a rain season maybe they can survive. Even if you can not find relief now but please*

share this with other Christians maybe there can be solution.” Again, “This Church is battling for food my brethren it needs one more time aid, maybe just as from next month up to December if it begin to rain there will be some wildvegetables which can sustain them.” Even when the early rains comes, it is very hard to live off of wild vegetables that the rain brings in until crops can be harvested.

Arao is also asking for \$300 to replace his rusted out roof before the rains arrive. He is especially worried about his children getting electrocuted from the leaking roof running on the electrical cords and plugs.
