RIM COUNTRY CHURCH WORK-

The Mullers have returned and things have returned to normal with the teaching. Brian and Dan finished teaching the book of Micah. I have completed the Wednesday class on Modesty and I am now looking to teach a few lessons on the work of the church during July.

Our sister Marilyn Hale, whom I mentioned last month, has sold or given away all her house possessions to move to the cancer center in Phoenix. Her sister moved to live with her daughter last month and now we are losing Marilyn. We pray that her cancer will go into remission. We do not know about her future plans about returning to Payson.

We sent out more **flyers** with little response, but I was called by a man who lives in Rye who received the flyer. Brian and I went to talk to him and his wife. They seem to be pretty well entrenched in faith-only doctrine and God speaking to him. We reasoned with the man but didn't get very far. He did like the flyer's appeal to truth seekers. I also received an email from a denominational person congratulating us on the flyer's appeal for people to consider the truth. He thought it was a very good appeal, but felt no inclination to ask to study with me.

Jere Jarrell from "The Way Church of Christ" continues to attend our Wednesday morning studies. In our last study there was some disagreement in the class and one of our older more sensitive members became very upset at what she took as arguing. She said it raised her blood pressure and if it continues she will not be able to attend.

We had two family **visitors** from "The Way Church of Christ" visit with us on Sunday, June 5. One of the sisters was to go into surgery the next day. We also had a summer visitor, Robert Overland, visit our Wednesday morning class twice. Brian and Sarah Muller's neighbor did not attend while the Mullers were gone, but she was back on the 3rd of July. Her health is affecting her attendance.

For Sunday **sermons** in June, I began a series on the Scheme of Redemption. The lessons were: Why the First Sin; Abraham and the Promises; God's use of the Old Testament; and God's Plan Hidden in the Prophets.

HEALTH- Joanne's pain has returned and we're trying to get her back into the doctor for relief. I am still having to use a high stool to preach from.

AFRICA - The requests for food in Zimbabwe by Dickson Dangirwa for the Mutendebvure and Dewedzo churches was fulfilled by a church and a widow with \$1200. The money was a little shorter than requested, but it was sufficient to cover most of the need.

Richard Maribo writes in his report about the church at Denzva, “The challenge which is on the ground so far is food shortages among the saints. Remember them in your prayers. They are affected very much.”

The request for the church in Masegri Mozambique was filled, but again, the money (\$250) was a little short, but able to meet the majority of the need. This need will be ongoing due to a lack of rain in general, work and drinkable water. This is a very difficult place to live but the people have little choice. Other than rain water caught off the roofs, the well water in that region is very salty.

The current church which helped with this relief will not be able to help again this year.

Requests: There is a request for a computer by Arao to be able to translate Bible materials into the native tongue languages. He had one given by Ron Chaffen over 10 years ago but it is not working or fixable any more. He is asking for \$350.

Castigo Cossa, a brother who had a stroke and can’t do manual labor but helps with the work at Javanyani is requesting a cell phone for communications. He is asking for \$150 to \$200.
